**DATE:** April 2, 2025

**RE:** Fiscal Year End 2025 – Priorities for School Board to Rank and Approve

State Code requires that school divisions may not carry-forward funds over any fiscal year without the reappropriation by the City Council. Virginia Code 22.1-89 and 1-100 states that local school boards manage and control funds appropriated by the City Council and may obligate and incur expenses prior to June 30. Many items requiring repair or replacement are not included in the Adopted Budget as they are one time or non-recurring in nature OR the inclusion of such items would mean that raises for teachers and staff would be severely limited.

The following is a listing of the items identified and recommended to be considered **IF** there is any availability of budget remaining **AFTER** the State releases the final payments in June and all payrolls and bills are paid for fiscal 2025. The School Board will be asked at the May 8, 2025 meeting, to vote on a resolution that would allow the Superintendent to obligate any remaining funds to items specifically identified in the resolution. This year, the School Board Vice-Chair requested that the School Board receive this information in advance and that the School Board rank the list in priority order. The items in RED are items recommended by Administration as a priority due to their direct impact on staff, students, and safety.

Please review these items and rank them in priority order so that the School Board can be ready to vote on the resolution at the May 8, 2025 school board meeting. Timing is critical as several of these items will require an RFP that would need to go out and come back to this School Board prior to the end of June in order to be obligated by June 30, 2025.
