AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 18, SECTION 10-18.1 ENTITLED "COOPERATION ENCOURAGED" OF THE POLICIES OF THE SUFFOLK CITY SCHOOL BOARD - SECOND READING

BE IT ORDAINED, by the School Board of the City of Suffolk, Virginia that Chapter 10, Article 18, Section 10-18.1 entitled "Cooperation encouraged" of the Policies of the Suffolk City School Board, be, and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Section 10-18.1. Cooperation encouraged. — A. Suffolk Public Schools shall cooperate with all non-profit and non-partisan agencies such as social services, recreation, health, fire, civil defense, and law enforcement agencies in promoting the general public interest and the educational welfare of the student.

The School Board shall cooperate with parent-teacher and parent-teacher-student associations and similar organizations that seek to advance programs designed to improve educational opportunities for all students consistent with state statutes.

B. The School Board encourages the establishment of parent-teacher organizations that seek to advance programs that improve educational opportunities for all students consistent with state and federal law. The School Board requests that parent-teacher organizations maintain a close relationship with the School Board, administration and staff, and that they consider School Board and school policies when planning activities. (Adopted January 12, 1995)
