## **RESIGNATIONS**

Forty-one (41) resignations which include twenty-four (24) instructional employees, and seventeen (17) non-instructional employees. The instructional employees include twenty-one (21) Teachers, and one (1) Speech Language Pathologist, one (1) AFJROTC Instructor, and one (1) Behavioral Specialists. There are six (6) retirees.

#### JOB ABATEMENT

Two (2) Custodians – Failure to Report to Work

## **DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

Intent to Recommend Dismissal from Employment – one (1) Teacher, and one (1) Intervention Support Staff No Longer Eligible to be Regularly Employed – one (1) Teacher

#### **INSTRUCTIONAL HIRES**

Fifty-seven (57) Teachers, one (1) NJROTC Instructor, one (1) Principal, two (2) Reading Specialists, one (1) Title I Interventionist, and three (3) Speech Language Pathologist, and two (2) School Counselors.

#### NON-INSTRUCTIONAL HIRES

Two (2) Accounting Tech II's, one (1) Staffing Specialist, two (2) Bus Aides, one (1) Bus Driver, and three (3) Teacher Assistants.

## SUBSTITUTE PERSONNEL

Two (2) Bus Aides, three (3) Bus Drivers, eleven (11) Teachers, and one (1) Teacher Assistant.

## EXTRA SUPPLEMENTS/STIPENDS

- Three (3) teachers to receive compensation for administering SOL tests to homebound/homebased students at all high schools at the rate of \$31.50 per hour.
- Thirty-two (32) school personnel to receive approval to serve as football, track & field, field hockey and sideline cheer coaches for middle schools during the 2024-25 school year.
- Five (5) coaches to receive a \$150 stipend each trip for driving multiple athletic trips for several schools in March 2025.
- Eight (8) school employees to receive compensation for participating in the Kindergarten Kickoff at Booker T. Washington Elementary school for the 2025-26 school year at the rate of \$36.77 per hour.
- Twenty-nine (29) school employees to receive compensation for serving as PBIS Facilitators for the 2024-25 school year ranging from \$200 \$800.
- One (1) employee serving as Transportation Supervisor to be assigned as acting Transportation Director until June 6, 2025 and to receive compensation of a 10% salary increase.
- Five (5) Middle School Assistant Directors of Student Activities to receive a \$1500 stipend for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the 2024-25 school year.
- Thirty-five (35) school personnel to receive approval for serving as sponsors and to receive extra-duty supplements for clubs and organizations at the middle schools.
- Sixty-three (63) school personnel to receive approval for serving as sponsors and to receive extra-duty supplements for clubs and organizations at the elementary schools.
- Sixty-two (62) school personnel to receive approval for serving as sponsors and to receive extra-duty supplements for clubs and organizations at the high schools.
- Sixty-three (63) school personnel to receive compensation for providing instructional support on April 26, 2025 for the SPS Saturday Academy in amounts ranging from \$70 \$300.
- Fifty-seven (57) school personnel to receive compensation for providing instructional support on May 3, 2025 for the SPS Saturday Academy in amounts ranging from \$70 \$300.
- Five (5) coaches to receive a \$150 stipend each trip for driving multiple athletic trips for several schools in April 2025.
- One (1) retired SPS Schools Interpreter to receive compensation for providing interpreter services at the 2025 SPS graduation ceremonies at the rate of \$28.38 per hour.
- Fifty-one (51) bus drivers and aides to receive a \$150 incentive bonus for perfect attendance during the month of April 2025.

- Four (4) school employees to receive a \$500 stipend each for providing coaching, modeling, and support as Principal Mentors.
- Nineteen (19) school employees to receive a \$1500 stipend for supporting grade level mentors as Lead Mentor Teachers.
- Thirty-two (32) school personnel to receive stipends for serving as football, track & field, field hockey and sideline cheer coaches for middle schools during the 2024-25 school year serving from \$400 to \$2000.
- Forty-nine (49) school employees to receive a stipend for additional duties as SPED teacher assistants for the 2024-25 school year in the amount of \$2000.
- Sixteen (16) school teachers to receive additional compensation for teaching an extra section at Nansemond River High School during the second semester of the 2024-25 school year at the rate of 1/8<sup>th</sup> of the individuals contracted pay.
- Sixty-three (63) school personnel to receive a stipend ranging from \$66.77 \$1212 for serving as sponsors and to receive extra-duty supplements for clubs and organizations at the elementary schools.
- Thirty-five (35) school personnel to receive a stipend ranging from \$100 \$1212 for serving as sponsors and to receive extra-duty supplements for clubs and organizations at the middle schools.
- One hundred and twenty-eight (128) employees to compensation for provided services as Instructional Resource Developers during the 2025-26 school year at the rate of \$40 per hour.
- One (1) employee to receive compensation for providing site visits and weekly monitoring of STAR Program students at the rate of \$40 per hour.
- Sixty-one (61) school personnel to receive a stipend ranging from \$66.50 \$2425 for serving as sponsors and to receive extra-duty supplements for clubs and organizations at the high schools.
- One hundred and eighty-one (181) school employees to receive compensation for serving on the Title I Summer Planning Proposals and Committees. Teachers will be compensated at \$36.77 per hour and paraprofessionals at their hourly rate.
- One hundred (100) school employees to receive a stipend for serving as Teacher Mentors during the 2024-25 school year with stipends ranting from \$250 to \$1000.
- One (1) Teacher Assistant to receive compensation for serving as a substitute Bus Aide at the rate of \$15.80 per hour.

- Three non-renewals requests for three (3) Teachers, two (2) School Attendance Liaisons, and one (1) SPED Teacher Assistant.
- Approval request for reappointments of school personnel for the 2025-26 school year.
- One (1) Substitute Teacher to be removed from the Substitute list at the request of the applicant.
- Recommendation: Assistant Principal.
