**RE:** Request for Approval of Waivers for Community Service Graduation

**Requirements and Midterm and Final Exams** 

Due to the Covid-19 closures and limits to access to educational opportunities, the Teaching and Learning Department requests school board approval for the following items:

- ➤ Waiver of the community service/service learning local graduation requirement for the 2021-2022 graduating seniors (Student Handbook-Requirements for Graduation)
- ➤ Eliminate Midterms and Final Exams for all high school level courses

The recommendation to eliminate midterms and final exams is to ensure the following:

- ➤ Encourage a focus on continuous student growth and mastery of skills through smaller common assessments
- ➤ Reduce the number of high-stakes testing given that students are required to take multiple standardized tests throughout high school (PSAT, SAT, ASVAB, AP, IB, Industry Credentials)
- ➤ Eliminate grade deflation for semester averages as a result of poor performance on exams and finals
- Eliminate the need for multiple instructional days dedicated to midterms and final exams
