AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 15, SECTION 9-15.5 ENTITLED "LOCKER SEARCHES; STUDENTS RESPONSIBLE FOR CONTENTS" OF THE POLICIES OF THE SUFFOLK CITY SCHOOL BOARD - FIRST READING AND ADOPTION

BE IT ORDAINED, by the School Board of the City of Suffolk, Virginia that Chapter 9, Article 15, Section 9-15.5 entitled "Locker searches; students responsible for contents" of the Policies of the Suffolk City School Board, be, and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Section 9-15.5. Locker searches; students responsible for contents. — Student lockers are school property and remain at all times under the control of the school. However, students are expected to assume full responsibility for the security of their lockers and are responsible for the content of their assigned locker at all times. Periodic general inspections of lockers will be conducted by school authorities for any reason at any time without notice, without student consent and without a search warrant. (Adopted August 14, 1997)

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, subsections, sections and chapters of the School Board's Policy Manual not amended or repealed shall remain in full force and effect.
