OUT OF ZONE REQUESTS

For the period of **April 2022**, there were thirty-five (35) out-of-zone requests processed. Five (5) were because of homelessness, six (6) were special circumstances, two (2) were for childcare, and twenty-two (22) were employee requests. In summation, two (2) requests were denied and thirty-three (33) requests were approved.

DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

Between **March 21, 2022** and **April 8, 2022**, there were forty-one (53) student disciplinary hearings conducted by the Office of Student Services.

- Twenty-one (21) students were assigned to Turlington Woods School.
- Thirteen (13) students were returned to their home base schools.
- Fourteen (14) students were suspended with Home Educational Services for a period of time.
- Three (3) was suspended for the remainder of the 2021-22 school year and assigned to the Tidewater Regional Alternative Educational Program (TRAEP) for the 2022-23 school year.
- One student was assigned to the TRAEP for the remainder of the 2021-22 school year.
- One student was assigned to the Southeastern Cooperative Educational Program for the remainder of the 2021-22 school year.
