AN ORDINANCE ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 23, SECTION 9-23.4:1, ENTITLED "PROTECTIVE ORDERS AND ORDERS PROHIBITING CONTACT WITH A CHILD" OF THE POLICIES OF THE SUFFOLK CITY SCHOOL BOARD — FIRST READING

BE IT ORDAINED, by the School Board of the City of Suffolk, Virginia that Chapter 9, Article 23, Section 9-23.4:1, entitled "Protective Orders and Orders Prohibiting Contact with a Child" of the Policies of the Suffolk City School Board, be, and the same is hereby added to read as follows:

Section 9-23.4:1. Protective Orders and Orders Prohibiting Contact with a Child.

— Any school principal who receives notice that a circuit court, general district court, juvenile and domestic relations district court, or magistrate has issued a protective order for the protection of any child who is enrolled at the school, or any other order prohibiting contact with such a child, notifies licensed instructional personnel and other school personnel who:

- (i) provide direct educational or support services to the protected child or the child subject to the order,
- (ii) have a legitimate educational interest in such information, and (iii) are responsible for the direct supervision of the protected child or the child subject to the order that such order has been issued.

Legal Authority - Virginia Code §22.1-288.2 (1950), as amended.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, subsections, sections and chapters of the School Board's Policy Manual not amended or repealed shall remain in full force and effect.
