AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 6-3.3 ENTITLED "INSPECTION REQUIREMENT" OF THE POLICIES OF THE SUFFOLK CITY SCHOOL BOARD - FIRST READING AND ADOPTION

BE IT ORDAINED, by the School Board of the City of Suffolk, Virginia that Chapter 6, Article 3, Section 6-3.3 entitled "Inspection requirement" of the Policies of the Suffolk City School Board, be, and the same is hereby added as follows:

Section 6-3.3. Inspection requirement. — A. Once installed on School Board property, the principal of the <u>school</u>, or the <u>principal's designee</u>, will have the responsibility to inspect the equipment on a regular basis, not less than monthly, and the authority, in the sole discretion of the principal, if the equipment is unsafe in any way, to recommend its repair or removal from school property. The principal may also restrict or deny the use of such equipment until such time, in the principal's sole opinion, that the equipment is restored to a safe condition.

B. The School Board, under the direction of the Director of Facilities and Planning, will perform or have performed, an inspection of all playground equipment, not less than annually to ensure the safe and proper condition of the equipment. If as a result of any such inspection(s) or as a result of items brought to the attention of the School Board, any repairs or removal of any equipment be deemed necessary, in the sole opinion of the Director of Facilities and Planning, the School Board will perform, or have performed, the necessary repairs. (Adopted February 9, 1995)
