A RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD FOR THE CITY OF SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA GRANTING THE SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT THE AUTHORITY TO OBLIGATE BY ENCUMBRANCE ANY REMAINING APPROPRIATED FUNDS BEFORE THE END OF THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR [JUNE 30, 2025] FOR CERTAIN DESIGNATED REPAIRS AND/OR PURCHASING NEEDS OF SUFFOLK PUBLIC SCHOOLS AS APPROVED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD

WHEREAS, pursuant to Virginia Code §22.1-89 (1950), as amended, local school boards manage and control funds made available to the school board for public schools and may incur costs and expenses; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Virginia Code §22.1-100 (1950), as amended, all sums of monies derived from local funds unexpended in any year shall remain a part of the funds of the governing body appropriating the funds; and

WHEREAS, the final date for a local school board to expend unencumbered funds appropriated by the local governing body for fiscal year 2024-2025 before such funds revert to the local governing body is June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, there are certain repairs and/or purchasing needs of Suffolk Public Schools that will require the expenditure of funds that must be made prior to June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the School Superintendent should be granted the authority to obligate by encumbrance any remaining appropriated funds before the end of the current fiscal year [June 30, 2025] as approved by the School Board.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED,** the School Superintendent is hereby granted the authority to obligate by encumbrance any remaining appropriated funds before the end of the current fiscal year [June 30, 2025] for repairs and/or purchases as approved by the School Board.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that at the School Board's regularly scheduled meeting of September 12, 2025 the School Superintendent shall report to the School Board all end of the year expenditures made pursuant to this grant of authority.
