AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 5-2.3 ENTITLED "REPORTING OF HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS; LABELING OF TOXIC MATERIALS" OF THE POLICIES OF THE SUFFOLK CITY SCHOOL BOARD - FIRST READING AND ADOPTION

BE IT ORDAINED, by the School Board of the City of Suffolk, Virginia that Chapter 5, Article 2, Section 5-2.3 entitled "Reporting of hazardous conditions; labeling of toxic materials" of the Policies of the Suffolk City School Board, be, and the same is hereby added as follows:

- **Section 5-2.3. Reporting of hazardous conditions; labeling of toxic materials.** A. It is the duty and responsibility of each employee of Suffolk Public Schools to assure that all equipment and grounds are free from hazardous conditions. Any perceived hazard shall be reported immediately to the <u>employee's supervisor</u>, the superintendent or designee for inspection and corrective action.
- B. The superintendent will name a designee to evaluate all art materials used in Suffolk Public Schools to identify those which are toxic, in accordance with criteria established by the Department of Education. All material used in Suffolk Public Schools which meets the criteria as toxic shall be so labeled and the use of such art materials shall be prohibited in kindergarten through grade five (5). (Adopted August 10, 1995)
