MOTION FOR CLOSED MEETING

A motion is needed to go into a closed meeting to discuss the following items and subjects pursuant to the Virginia Freedom of Information Act found at Virginia Code Section 2.2-3711:

- 1. The discussion and/or consideration of Student Expulsion Hearing Number 24/25-1EH, which involves a request for a student expulsion, where the discussion in an open meeting would involve disclosure of information contained in the student's scholastic record.
- Record Review 24/25-4RR regarding the assignment of a student to Turlington Woods School, where the discussion in an open meeting would involve disclosure of information contained in the student's scholastic record.
- 3. Employee Appeal 2425-1 regarding a recommendation to dismiss a Safety Monitor employed by Suffolk Public Schools.
- 4. Consultation with legal counsel regarding actual or probable litigation, where such consultation or briefing in open meeting would adversely affect the negotiating or litigating posture of the School Board and more specifically as it relates to United States of America v. School Board of the City of Suffolk.
- 5. The discussion and/or consideration of the names of prospective appointees to serve on Citizen Advisory Committees.
