\$51.3m 2023-2032 Result:

> \$14,300,000 LESS funding than requested for major repairs due to transfer to pay for NSES Addition

\$3.575 2022-2023 TRF to NSES 2024-2027 \$6.685m 2028-2032

NOTE: City combined Hazardous substance abatement to Major Repairs/Systems Replacement at the requested \$75,000 per year.





Northern Shores Elementary School 20 Classroom Addition

- 29,390 square feet.
- 20 additional classrooms 500 additional seats.
- Teacher workspaces on each floor.
- Student restrooms on each floor.
- Cafeteria addition on west side of kitchen, 120 additional cafeteria seats.
- Two existing classrooms will be reduced in size where the new addition ties into the existing building. Net loss of 50 classroom seats. Reduced size classrooms can be repurposed.
- Net gain of 450 classroom seats

\$1.9 million set aside to replace HVAC Chiller at KFMS

SAVES the City and taxpayers \$1.9 million dollars

Result:

New standing Chiller replaces 21 year old chiller at no cost to taxpayers and no additional debt for the City.






Note: Estimated cost install sprinkler system, HVAC, and elevator/stairwells up to code is \$5m
