

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 10, SECTION 10-10.1 ENTITLED “REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT; GROUNDS FOR A TRESPASS” OF THE POLICIES OF THE SUFFOLK CITY SCHOOL BOARD – FIRST READING AND ADOPTION**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the School Board of the City of Suffolk, Virginia that Chapter 10, Article 10, Section 10-10.1 entitled “Registration requirement; grounds for a trespass” of the Policies of the Suffolk City School Board, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 10-10.1. Registration requirement; grounds for a trespass.** — A. Principals shall establish procedures requiring all visitors to register at the school office upon arrival. Any persons found to be engaged in or advocating illegal activity while on school property, including school buses, shall be is reported by the principal to the local law enforcement authority.

B. No one may possess or consume any alcoholic beverage in or on the grounds of any public school during school hours or school or student activities. In addition, no one may consume, and no organization shall serve, any alcoholic beverage in or on the grounds of any public school after school hours or school or student activities, except for religious congregations using wine for sacramental purposes only.

C. Tobacco Products and Nicotine Vapor Products, use of tobacco products and nicotine vapor products is not permitted in schools, at school-sponsored events, or in school vehicles.

D. Anyone who goes on school property after having been forbidden officially to do so either orally or in writing or by a sign posted on the property can be charged with a misdemeanor. Upon conviction he shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by confinement in jail not exceeding twelve (12) months or both. It is against the law for anyone without official consent to go upon at night any school property for any purpose other than to attend a meeting held on school property. Any person violating these provisions shall be guilty of a trespass. Upon conviction he shall be fined not less than \$5.00, no more than \$25.00. (Adopted January 12, 1995; Revised November 16, 1995; Ordinance 19/20-56)


