AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 6, SECTION 6-6.1 ENTITLED "BUILDING MUST BE ACCESSIBLE TO THE DISABLED" OF THE POLICIES OF THE SUFFOLK CITY SCHOOL BOARD - FIRST READING

BE IT ORDAINED, by the School Board of the City of Suffolk, Virginia that Chapter 6, Article 6, Section 6-6.1 entitled "Building must be accessible to the disabled" of the Policies of the Suffolk City School Board, be, and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Section 6-6.1. Building must be accessible to the disabled. — Plans for new and remodeled buildings must offer such design, construction, and accommodations as to make them accessible to and usable by individuals with disabilities disabled persons as required by law. The School Board will review construction plans to ensure that new and remodeled buildings will be made fully accessible. (Adopted February 9, 1995)
