

Instructional Planning: The SPS 2022 Summer Series

Summer Academy

intensive support, targeted skill building, SOL remediation, course and credit recovery

Summer School

traditional summer school model, instructional support, power skills building, course remediation

Summer Explore

intensive support, targeted skill building, SOL remediation, course and credit recovery

Summer Bridge

introduction to new courses, advanced instruction, critical thinking and problem solving skills, creativity, targeted skills





Instructional Planning: 4 X 4 Block Scheduling

SUFFOLK PUBLIC SCHOOLS

- Transition the High School Master Schedule to a 4 X 4 Block Schedule
 - Allows students to take more courses during their high school career
- Adv. Diploma=26 credits, Standard=22 credits
 - Improves the graduation rate for students who need additional opportunities and support
 - Increases opportunities for SPED and ELL Students
 - May require additional building instructional staff
- School Board Vote=October 2022

Human Resources and Talent Acquisition

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- SPS expanded recruitment for talent acquisition:
 - William and Mary, University of Virginia
 - Old Dominion, Longwood, Liberty
 - North Carolina A & T, East Carolina
- Hybrid approach for job fairs:
 - Virtual-March 9th, 10th, and 11th
 - Face to Face-May 14th
- Recruitment and Retention Incentives:
 - \$250 signing bonus for new teachers (99)
 - \$2000 bonus for hard to fill positions (65)
 - \$5000 Recruitment Incentive for Public Education (7)
 - \$7500 Grow Your Own Grant (1)

- Minimal costs for setup:
 - Shelving and Storage
