### **Submission:**

Due to the
Virginia Department of Education (VDOE)
May 9, 2025





- Application submitted annually to receive federal funds for special education under Title VI-B of IDEA 2004.
- VDOE provides each locality with guidelines, part of which is to have the application reviewed and approved by the local SEAC and School Board.
- Provides federal funds that must be used ONLY for the provision of special education services and related services to students with disabilities.

## **Additional Components**

- Local Jails Education Program
   Special education services provided to incarcerated youth
- Proportionate Set-Aside (PSA)
   Federal funds for students in parentally-placed private schools
- Maintenance of Effort (MOE)
   Same local/state levels of funding as the previous year



### IDEA Part B, Section 611: School-aged children

 Pays salary and benefits for some special education teachers, some special education teacher assistants, job coaches, and bus assistants





Application Allocation - \$3,534,046

Title VI, Part B provides financial assistance to school divisions serving students with disabilities (preK-12).

### IDEA Part B, Section 619: Children ages 3-5 years

 Pays salary and benefits for a special education (preschool) teacher

Application Allocation - \$69,020.00
